Commissioner for NYC Housing Preservation & Development (HPD)

The Honorable Adolfo Carrión, Jr. was appointed Commissioner of HPD by Mayor Adams on January 30, 2022. Prior, Mr. Carrión was the CEO of Metro Futures LLC, a real estate development and consulting firm he founded in 2012.
